**UKRAINE'S POLITICAL TENSION WITH RUSSIA AND ITS
IMPLICATION ON GHANAIS IN UKRAINE**

I am directed to forward, herewith, copy of Note Verbale No. 77/NV/2022 dated 21st March, 2022, by which the Embassy of Hungary in Prague, is transmitting information on steps to be taken by foreign students, including Ghanaian students displaced by the crisis in Ukraine and willing to be enrolled into Hungarian Universities, to complete their programmes.
